Pilot Information

This year the FAA has specified different frequencies for Valdez Tower, Air Show and Ground. **These will be used when the tower is open. Listen to AWOS 118.8 and this will be on the NOTAM as well for tower hours of operation.**

Frequencies:

Juneau FSS: 122.2

Valdez AWOS: 118.8

Valdez Tower: 119.05

Valdez Ground: 120.1

Valdez Air Boss: 118.1

When the tower is OPEN use the below reporting points for your INITIAL contact. Further reporting is not needed unless requested by the tower 119.05

If you are coming in when the **tower is not open** then use the following frequency and reporting points:

Valdez Ground is 120.1 and you will be directed to parking. Parking assistance is available. Please park as close as possible (but don't cause hangar rash) to the plane next to you, we need to maximize our parking tie downs! We will have ropes and cables for wing tie downs. All tie downs are at your own risk.



Airspace will be closed for brief periods during aerobatic displays Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Arrivals will be directed to hold until airspace is open.
